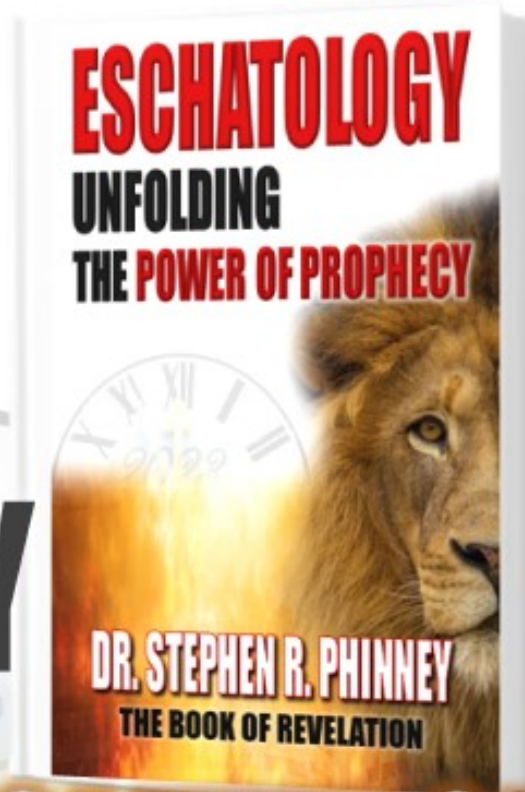

THE SEVEN PLAGUES

TODAY'S PASSAGE **Revelation 15:1-8**

*“Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels who had seven plagues, which are the last, because in them the wrath of God is finished. And I saw something like a sea of glass mixed with fire, and those who had been victorious over the beast and his image and the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, holding harps of God. And they *sang the song of Moses, the bond-servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, “Great and marvelous are Your works, O Lord God, the Almighty; Righteous and true are Your ways, King of the nations! “Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy; For ALL THE NATIONS WILL COME AND WORSHIP BEFORE YOU, FOR YOUR RIGHTEOUS ACTS HAVE BEEN REVEALED.” After these things I looked, and the temple of the tabernacle of testimony in heaven was opened, and the seven angels who had the seven plagues came out of the temple, clothed in linen, clean and bright, and girded around their chests with golden sashes. Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God, who lives forever and ever. And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power; and no one was able to enter the temple until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished.”*

THE SEVEN PLAGUES

THE BOWLS OF WRATH

This chapter is rather short, but long in importance. Within this little chapter but mighty reveal, we find seven angels who have the seven LAST PLAGUES. John observes each of these angels holding “bowls of wrath.” These actions of God are the last and final consequences delivered to man. The remainder of consequences we see in the book of Revelation are either directed directly at Satan and his spirit beings or ramifications that man brings on himself resulting in their own acts of rebellion from the seven bowls.

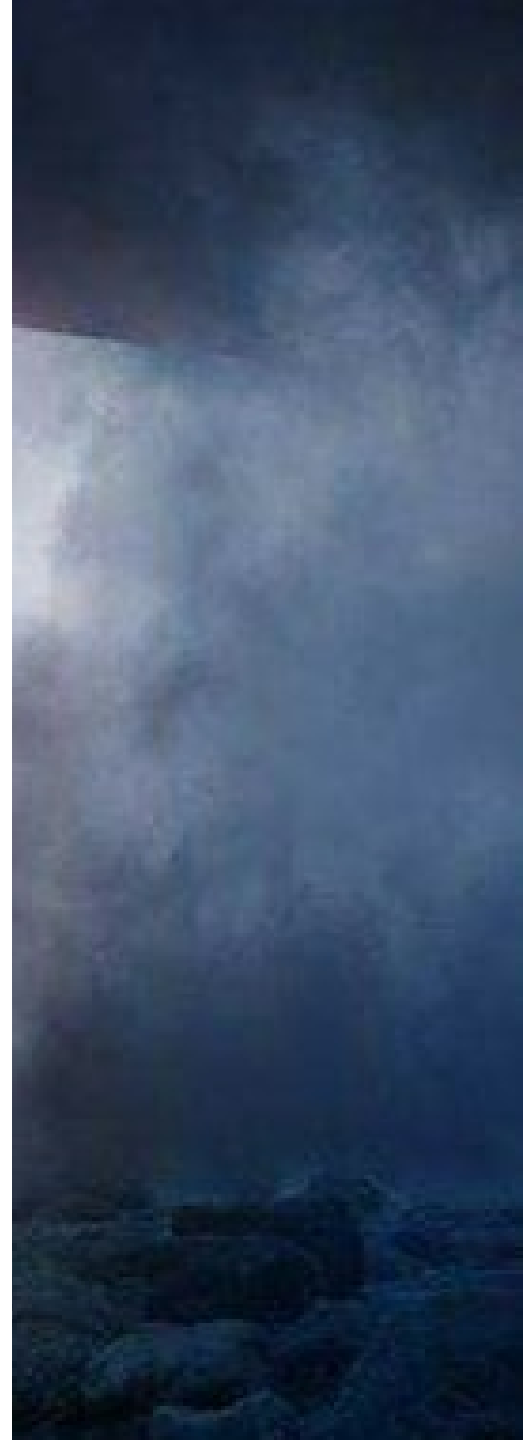

CONSUMMATION

Consummation, for those who are new to the principle, is the act of a groom penetrating the woman through sexual relations, dispelling his seed in her, and proving that she indeed is a virgin by coming forth from the room revealing her blood on the sheet of the marriage bed. It is these acts that reveal there is nothing between him and his bride. Both are free from all worries, doubts, and fears before penetration, which can only happen when his wrath is completed/finished. It is the male's responsibility to ensure that the woman is not distracted from serving him. It also reveals to the father of the bride that this man can care for her as a priest (spiritual leader), king (leadership), and warrior (protector) and that in no way will he keep her from him.



OUR HUSBAND SHOWS VIOLENCE

You might be one of those “Christians” who find it difficult to embrace our Husband showing such acts of “violence” through the fullness of His character. If you are, you might want to study the Word a bit closer. If you are only reading the Word's comfort passages because of your fear of God's Wrath, that means Jesus, too, implores you to study 1John. Fear involves punishment (1John 4:18), and punishment is bathed in un-belief. It is estimated that only 12% of the Body of Christ have studied the book of Revelation. These believers tell me that it is too difficult to understand that it is filled with God's “harshness.”



THE GLASS SEA

Speaking from the Hebrew customs, the sea of glass is typically believed to be the molten sea or great brazen laver before the Mercy Seat of the earthly temple, for the priests' purification, typifying the baptism of water and the Spirit who commissioned kings and priests unto God. We see this in Heaven, not a replicated version but the eternal view of the model God instructed Moses to demonstrate via the Red (fire) sea.

God is and has always been about finishing the work that He started. We are seeing the finishing work of God through the pouring out of these Vials. Verse 3 reveals the song the 144,000 are about to play and sing.

And they sang the song of Moses, the bond-servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, "Great and marvelous are Your works, O Lord God, the Almighty; Righteous and true are Your ways, King of the nations! (Rev 15:3).

Moses's song customarily celebrates God's mighty hand of the deliverance of His people Israel, God's elect. The Lamb song celebrates the great redemption He purchased by the blood He shed on the Cross. If He had not laid His life down and poured out His blood, the priest's blood sacrifices in the Old Testament would have been fruitless. As most believers know, all the bloodshed of man and beast was to point to the song of the Lamb.

THE KING OF **KINGS**

Before Jesus can take the position of King of kings, He must first abolish the nations. It will take place through this final fury. Then and only then will Christ positionally declare Himself as the King of all nations.

Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy; For ALL THE NATIONS WILL COME AND WORSHIP BEFORE YOU, FOR YOUR RIGHTEOUS ACTS HAVE BEEN REVEALED (Rev 15:4).

We learn from this verse that there are three primary reasons why all should fear God and glorify Him and Him alone:

- 1. He is Holy.**
- 2. All nations are required to worship Him.**
- 3. God must fulfill His mandates.**

God is a righteous judge, and a God who has indignation every day.
(Psalm 7:11)

Most Emergent believers of our day only preach on the love of God and not on His judgments. The judgments being poured forth from these Vials are His ultimate act of Love, not toward the evildoers, but in response to answering the call of His children. I certainly understand why the postmodern church turned Emergent or lukewarm. Nonetheless, it is only half of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Most churches base their view of Christ on the days that He walked the earth. His first coming was for the sole purpose of bringing peace to all men and opening the door for His engagement to His Bride – to avoid His everlasting Judgement.

IN CONCLUSION

The only thing that saves us from the great blood bath of the seven Vials is to be covered in the blood of Jesus. God's primary tools of redemption are water, blood, and fire. If you're not covered in the blood of Christ, you, too, will be engulfed in this blood bath and certainly by the all-consuming fire of hell that is nipping at our feet. All those who fail to receive His mercy and grace will then suffer His wrath of judgment performed in His "strange work" (Isaiah 28:21).
