STUDY CHAPTER FOUR
KEY VERSES
4:28-33

"All this happened to Nebuchadnezzar the king. Twelve months later he was walking on the roof of the royal palace of Babylon. The king reflected and said, 'Is this not Babylon the great, which I myself have built as a royal residence by the might of my power and for the glory of my majesty?' While the word was in the king's mouth, a voice came from heaven, saying, 'King Nebuchadnezzar, to you it is declared: sovereignty has been removed from you, and you will be driven away from mankind, and your dwelling place will be with the beasts of the field. You will be given grass to eat like cattle, and seven periods of time will pass over you until you recognize that the Most High is ruler over the realm of mankind and bestows it on whomever He wishes.' Immediately the word concerning Nebuchadnezzar was fulfilled; and he was driven away from mankind and began eating grass like cattle, and his body was drenched with the dew of heaven until his hair had grown like eagles' feathers and his nails like birds' claws."



ON THE ROOF WITH THE KING

Twelve months after the second dream was interpreted, Nebuchadnezzar finds himself on the palace roof. A place kings often enjoyed taking in their kingdom's glory. As the king was gazing out over his vast empire, he said, *"Is this not Babylon the great, which I myself have built as a royal residence by the might of my power and for the glory of my majesty?"* Ouch! Not good. While we know that pride is one of the names assigned to Satan, the king's confession provoked the Living God. Out of Heaven, God speaks.

GOD KEEPS HIS WORD

Fact. God did not grant Nebuchadnezzar any grace. As we see in the thousand-year judgment period of Jesus, God spoke the judgment and immediately carried out the consequences. The once-proud king becomes less than human. He went from purple robes to green grass – in an instant. He was naked and ashamed.

PRIDE IS NOT EASILY BROKEN

Nebuchadnezzar continued in his brokenness process for seven long years. Breaking a person of pride is equal to taming a snake. While humanity would prefer to be “spanked” and move on, this is not a modality that God uses with proud people.

IN CONCLUSION

Nebuchadnezzar's mental madness symbolizes the masses who will be under the power-grabbing insane mind of the final Antichrist during the seven-year Tribulation. Furthermore, this Antichrist will be Babylonian, sitting and reigning from the Jewish temple, soon to be rebuilt.

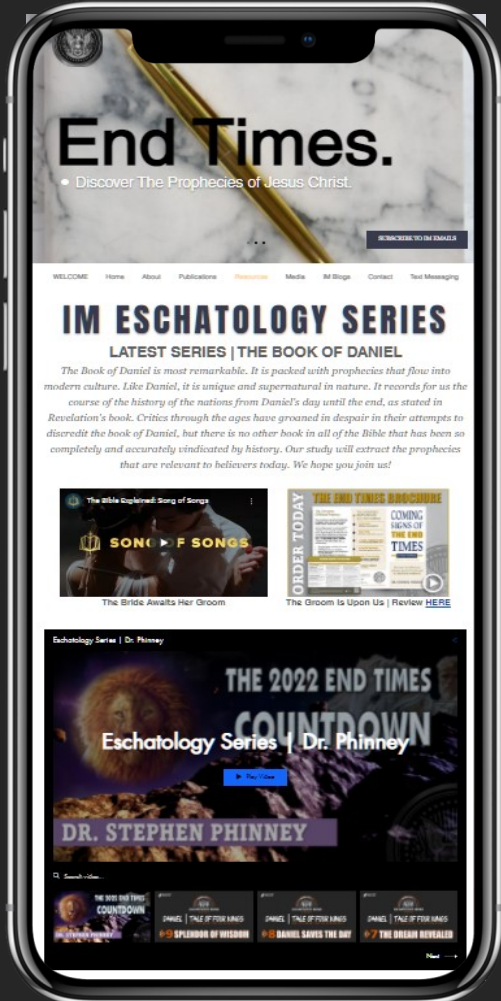
