TRIBULATION

Tribulation comes from the resistance of those who refuse to pay tribute to a method or person who demands loyalty. When one refuses to show tribute, there is Hell to pay. Toward the end of the first half of Satan's reign, many, mostly Gentiles, catch on to the fake peace the global Chancellor demands. When peace is demanded, it reveals it is a fake peace. CHAPTER ELEVEN

KEY VERSES

11:5-7

Then the king of the South will grow strong, along with one of his princes who will gain ascendancy over him and obtain dominion; his domain will be a great dominion indeed. After some years they will form an alliance, and the daughter of the king of the South will come to the king of the North to carry out a peaceful arrangement. But she will not retain her position of power, nor will he remain with his power, but she will be given up, along with those who brought her in and the one who sired her as well as he who supported her in those times. But one of the descendants of her line will arise in his place, and he will come against their army and enter the fortress of the king of the North, and he will deal with them and display great strength.

RESULTS OF THE WAR

NORTH & SOUTH


FORESHADOWING OF THE ANTICHRIST

He clarifies that he will NOT honor any other god besides the god he serves. He proclaims he serves the god that no one else knows, Satan himself. He will take action against the present world powers with the help of Satan's power. He will only honor those who serve Satan directly.

IN CONCLUSION

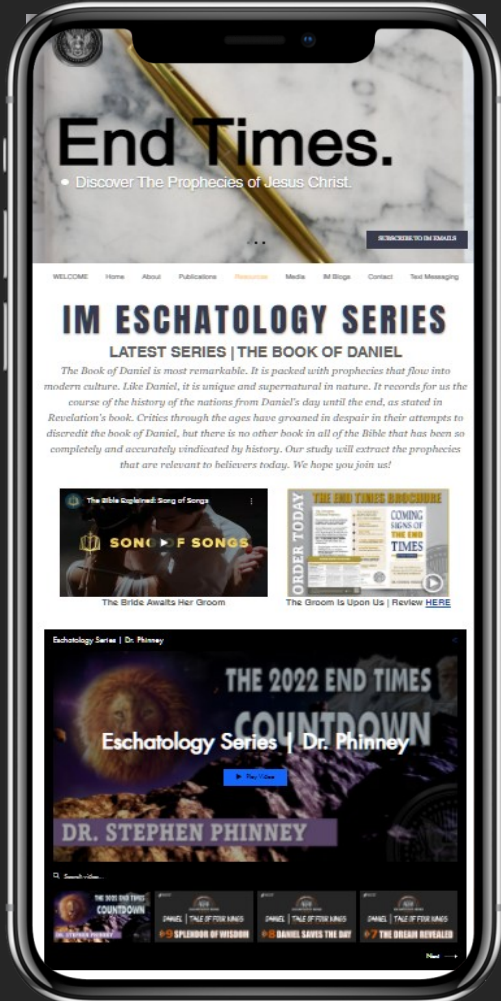
