

TWO PROPHETS

What is up with the "Two Prophets" Revelation? Who are these two prophets? The first prophet is not debated by scholars – Elijah. However, the second opens controversy. Some say Moses, while most say, Enoch. My position leans toward Enoch while not negating the possibility of Moses. Why do I believe this? Both prophets must be prophets that did NOT die a physical death. That leaves Elijah and Enoch. However, history reveals Moses reappeared at Christ's transfiguration (Matt. 17:3). This single notation causes some to believe Moses will be one of the prophets. We do know that God miraculously took Enoch without death.

TWO PARTS TO THE TRIBULATION FAKE PEACE | DESTRUCTION 144,000

First and foremost, the first half is focused on eradicating the remaining Gentiles. Since Satan will present himself as the Jews Messiah, his focus will be on the Jews in the second half. The two prophets are and will be authentic Jews from a pure bloodline. In the second half, Satan is likely to present an image of being the Isa (Jesus) of the descendants of Ishmael – the illegitimate son of Abraham. When the Bible references "fake Jews," this is the group referenced. While the Islamic people are and have been Israel's greatest enemy through the ages, their claim to be pure bloodline descendants from the seed of Abraham is correct. Satan will play off of this partial truth. The role of the two prophets is to separate the goats (fake Jews) from the real (pure bloodline Jews from the 12 Tribes).

REVIEWING SCRIPTURES

STUDY CHAPTER TEN **KEY VERSES** 10:5-7

I lifted my eyes and looked, and behold, there was a certain man dressed in linen, whose waist was girded with a belt of pure gold of Uphaz. His body also was like beryl, his face had the appearance of lightning, his eyes were like flaming torches, his arms and feet like the gleam of polished bronze, and the sound of his words like the sound of a tumult. Now I, Daniel, alone saw the vision, while the men who were with me did not see the vision; nevertheless, a great dread fell on them, and they ran away to hide themselves.



THE TWO PROPHETS

While the purpose of the two prophets in the second half of the Tribulation is certainly clear, God withholds their identity from humanity. However, certain passages in the Word give us foresight of the possibilities. If a reader does not carefully review the prophecies, controversy will erupt.



THE TWO WITNESSES in the Inbulation REVELATION 11:1-13

The Son of Man, Jesus, caused a deep sleep to fall upon Daniel. Then, Jesus touched him, asking him to stand while He imparted these profound prophetic warnings (Dan. 10:11). He assures Daniel that his voice is heard by the living God (Dan. 10:12). He readies Daniel regarding what will happen to the Hebrew people in the latter days (Dan. 10:14). He warns him that the prince of Greece in both the old and the new is about to come (Dan. 10:20). He explains who the leaders are within Nebuchadnezzar's dream while giving him details of the rebirth of Rome and Greece stated in Revelation (Dan. 11). Finally, the Son of Man reveals that no one who stands firmly with me against these forces except Michael the Archangel.

THE POWER OF THE PROPHETS

As Daniel was the only witness at the time to witness the first struggle to end all earthly empires, the two prophets of **Revelation will suffer** the same burden. Also, as Daniel's power was directly from God, as for the two prophets, it will be the same.



IN CONCLUSION

The masses will celebrate the deaths of the two prophets - And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them and celebrate; and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth. (Revelation 11:10) But wait, there's more; after the three and a half days, doom and gloom hit them like a blast of wind. But after the three and a half days, the breath of life from God came into them, and they stood on their feet; and great fear fell upon those who were watching them. And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here." Then they went up into heaven in the cloud, and their enemies watched them. And in that hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell; seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven. (Revelation 11:11-13)
