



THE KING IS RESTLESS

This dignified king hastened to the lion's den to check Daniel's status personally. Without hesitation, Daniel shouts out the familiar words the king was accustomed to hearing, "O king, live forever!" Can you imagine the relief of the king?

THE ANGEL OF SALVATION



We are not told the moment the angel of God arrives to save Daniel. However, we know that the lions have not been fed for seven days. They were starving. Likely, the angel was there before Daniel arrived in the den. Furthermore, as to the IF Daniel was honored with the experience of seeing the angel, well, it doesn't matter. The fact that Daniel was delivered from the mouths of the lions is enough.

As in the case of Shadrach,
Meshach, and Abed-nego was
delivered from the fiery furnace
without a single hair on their
heads scorched, so was Daniel
delivered from the lion's den.
While humanity tends to focus
on Daniel and his faith, honestly,
it wasn't about Daniel.
