



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The Exchanged Life

This term was originally used by Hudson Taylor to define the exchange that takes place upon Salvation; we exchange our life for His. Many teachers of the Cross also use this term to explain an indwelt believer appropriating their co-death, burial, and resurrection with Christ. One of the most common Scriptures used in this exchange is Galatians 2:20, "Not I, but Christ." Truth being said, all believers in Christ receive the exchanged life upon the moment of their Salvation.

What Is Discipleship?

Disciple (mathetes) means "a learner" – one who willingly accepts instruction.

Discipler (didaskalos) is an "instructor," or "teacher," who produces followers of a discipline of a particular teacher.

Discipline (paldeuo) to influence conscious will and action through methods of correction to promote conformity to Divine Truth.

What Is Discipleship? (Continued)

Discipleship = The process an instructor, teacher or mentor uses to influence a willing learner to follow a particular leader in beliefs and deed.

Christ-As-Life Discipleship = A Servant Leader (disciple of Christ) who is compelled to voluntarily instruct others in becoming an indwelt follower of Christ Jesus in Truth and deed. When fronted with lies (truth without context), he/she is not timid about reproving, correcting and re-instructing by making use of Divine Truth – the Bible.






